6. This new bridge uses the same abutments as the former Rock Island bridge in the same location.

8. This park was named for a former Fairfield Mayor. How hard can it be to find his first two initials? (_____)
9. Trust me, I'm not pulling your bow string—Iowa has more spans of this historic design than any other state.

The Rules

The Scavenger Hunt opens May 29, 2021 at sunrise and closes on July 2, 2021 at 4:00 PM. One entry per person. Pick up punch cards at The Ride: Bike Sales and Service (123 North Court Street), trail-head kiosks, Fairfield Rec Center, MUM Rec Center, or www.jeffersoncountyltrails.org. There are two types of clue locations: 1. Checkpoint clue locations are an orange punch with CP number sticker. Punches are zip-tied to a structure. 2. Landmark clue locations are a particular landmark along the trail. Participants will fill in the blank on the punch card with the answer related to the landmark in the clue. Clues are located in the trail corridor or public park areas. Participants that find all 10 clues will be entered in drawings for prizes. Submit completed punch cards to The Ride: Bike Sales and Service or to: Jefferson County Trails Council, P.O. Box 2375, Fairfield, IA 52556. The drawing for prizes will take place via Facebook Live on the Jefferson County Trails Council Facebook page during Fairfield First Fridays on July 2, 2021 (or in person as current pandemic conditions permit).
