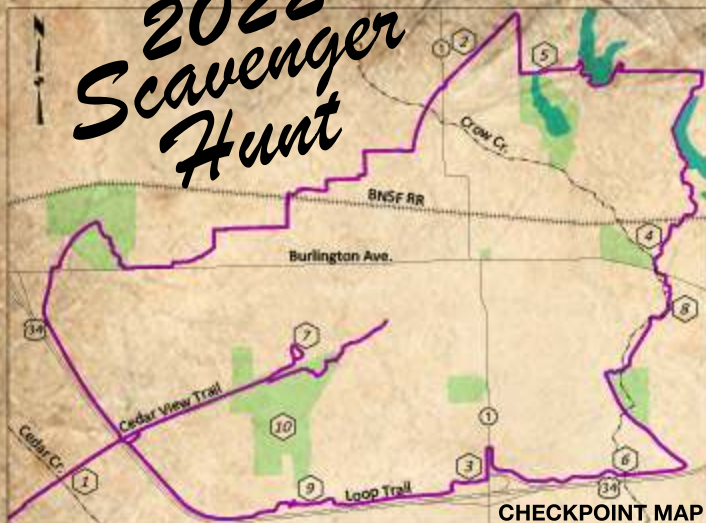

The Rules

The Scavenger Hunt opens May 28, 2022 at sunrise and closes on July 1, 2022 at 4:00 PM. One entry perperson. Pick up punch cards at The Ride: Bike Sales and Service (123 North Court Street), trailhead kiosks, Fairfield Rec Center, or www.jeffersoncountyclouds.org.

All clues lead to an orange punch with CP number sticker. The clues are in the form of a partially-completed Wordle Puzzle. The Wordle answer is a 5-letter word. Letters in the initial guesses highlighted green are the correct letter in the correct position, letters highlighted yellow appear in the answer but are in the wrong position in the guess. The answer for each clue is a word describing where the orange punch is hidden. Some, but not all, of the initial guesses are related in some other way than sharing common letters with the answer. Two Wordle answers will be published per week during the hunt on the Jefferson County Trails Council Facebook page.

Punches are zip-tied to a structure. Punches are located in the trail corridor or public park areas. Participants that find all 10 punches will be entered in drawings for prizes. Submit completed punch cards to The Ride: Bike Sales and Service or to: Jefferson County Trails Council, P.O. Box 2375, Fairfield, IA 52556.

The drawing for prizes will take place during Fairfield First Fridays on July 1, 2022. Need not be present to win. To report missing or damaged check point punches, call Steve at 641-919-5565.
