Orange hole punches with a CP number sticker are located in the trail corridor or public park areas. The location of the orange hole punch corresponds with the written clue and location shown on map. There is no orange punch at CP 6, get a rubbing instead! Participants that find all 10 clues will be entered in drawings for prizes. Submit completed punch cards to The Ride: Bike Sales and Service or to: Jefferson County Trails Council, P.O. Box 2375, Fairfield, IA 52556.
